THE SCHOOL

Founded in 2014, Vizyon College is a private school operated under the jurisdiction of the Turkish Ministry of Education and recognized by Microsoft as a Microsoft Showcase School. In 2019, it was selected as the best of best amongst Microsoft showcase schools. It is the first and only project school of SEBIT, the most prominent education software company in Turkey, and uses artificial intelligence as a part of its curriculum. It provides one-to-one tablets to each student, encouraging them to use those tablets to enhance learning.

OUR VISION

To be a global brand that brings vision to education.

OUR MISSION

To equip our students with the knowledge and skills that will help them be happy and successful individuals throughout their lives.

ACADEMIC PROGRAM

The curriculum for the class of 2023 offers classes mostly in Turkish. For 9th and 10th grades, our school provides main courses: Physics, Biology, Chemistry, History, Geography, Mathematics, Turkish Language and Literature, Religion and Ethics, Philosophy, Foreign Language (English), and Second Foreign Language (Spanish or German). The biggest credit is given to English.

After 10th grade, students choose one of the two academic tracks: Math-Science or Languages-Math. Math-Science offers advanced STEM classes, whereas Languages-Math offers advanced language and social science classes. To graduate from our school, students have to attend 42-hour long classes per week.

CLUBS

Over twenty clubs are offered to students each year, ranging from arts, sports, STEM, languages, and performance. Only students in grades 9 and 10 can enroll in these clubs. In addition, students are encouraged to start and lead their clubs at school.

CURRICULUM INFORMATION / GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Depending on the students' academic interest, they might select a course concentration in: (1) Science and Math, which requires: Biology – 8 semesters, Physics- 8 semesters, Chemistry – 8 semesters, Mathematics – 8 semesters, and Geometry – 4 semesters or; (2) Languages and Math, which requires: Literature – 8 semesters, Psychology – 4 semesters, Geography – 8 semesters, History - 8 semesters, Mathematics – 8 semesters, and Geometry – 4 semesters.

Regardless of curriculum focus, by graduation all students have completed a rigorous curriculum. A partial listing of the required courses for all high school students are as follows according to the prefered academic track:

Physics = 4 semesters

Biology = 4 semesters

Chemistry = 4 semesters

Mathematics = 8 semesters

Turkish Language & Literature = 8 semesters

History = 8 semesters

Philosophy = 8 semesters

Religion & Ethics = 8 semester

When evaluating a transcript of a Private Vizyon Anatolian High School applicant, please consider that all of our students follow the Turkish National Anatolian High School Curriculum and that AP or IB classes are not offered.

GRADING SYSTEM

Even though our school does not use a ranking system, it awards students with honors and high honors each semester based on their final semester grade point averages. The school follows a 100-point scale, and the final grades are calculated based on the weighted average by the number of class hours a week of each course. Criteria for interpreting a final grade can be done with the system below.

Point Grade Value Rank

85 - 100 = Excellent

70 - 84.99 = Good

60 - 69,99 = Average

50 - 59,99 = Passing

0 - 49,99 = Failing

ACADEMIC HONORS

HONOR ROLL

Given to students whose GPA is between 70-84%

CERTIFICATE OF MERIT

Given to students who receive consecutive high honor rolls for 3 or more semesters

HIGH HONOR ROLL

Given to students whose GPA is between 85-100%

CERTIFICATE OF HONOR

Given to students who participate in extracurriculars and demonstrate exemplary personal qualities alongside high academic performance

MERIT-BASED SCHOLARSHIPS

Awarded to exceptional students who demonstrate academic achievement and intellectual promise, as well as impressive extracurricular and community involvement
